RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITORS

- A 900 lbs. and under
- B 1200 lbs. and under
- C 1500 lbs. and under
- D 1800 lbs. and under
- E 2100 lbs. and under

Rules and Regulation

1. There will be only one driver per tractor, per class driver must be at least 16 years of age
2. There will be immediate disqualification for going out of bounds.
3. No chains, cleats, tracks or 4 wheel drive
4. All engines must be stock in appearance
5. Tractors must be weighed for each class including driver. Tires may be loaded. All weight added must be securely attached to wheels or frame. All brackets to be attached in a safe manner not to interfere with driver or hitching. No weight shall be on or in the way of seat, clutch or brakes. If a weight or frame is lost while pulling, pull will be counted as a try but no measure
6. Front weight must not exceed 18" forward of the front-most position of the tractor including weights.
7. Boat must be hooked off a safe draw bar using a clevis or ring able to accept a 3/8 slip-hook loosely not to exceed in height of 12" for all classes. Hitches will be measured to the pulling point on clevis or ring where the hook sits. For clevises and rings that drop or hang down hitch will be measured at the center of pinning spot of clevis or ring.
8. Tractor must have wheelie bar or bars able to support tractor in class it is entered and must not allow front axle to raise more than 14" or tractor will be disqualified.
9. Driver must stay in seat of tractor at all times. No bouncing or rocking or forcefully moving tractor with the use of body weight - 1st warning, 2nd disqualification.
10. Each tractor will be allowed 3 minutes (time starts when tractor is hitched) or 3 tries. A try consists of the bolt moving 1 inch or more.
11. A full pull of 100' to be done in one continuous movement. If boat stops for more than 5 seconds it will be counted as a try and measured.
12. Top three tractors are subject to reweigh.
13. Copy of rules will be available at pulling area.
14. All decisions are final that are made by Superintendent or pull officials. Slight modifications of rules may be made by Superintendent or pull officials at any time in the event of conflict or local pad or boat conditions including scale and weights. NO IFS ANDS OR BUTS!
